

By-law No. 17, 2010 TARIFFS, CREDIT CONTROL AND DEBT COLLECTION BY-LAW, 2010

BY-LAW

To provide for the implementation and enforcement by the Ubuntu municipality of its policies regarding tariffs, credit control and debt collection; and for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the Ubuntu municipality, as follows:-

Definitions

1. In this By-law, unless the context otherwise indicates -

"Municipality" means the Ubuntu municipality; and

"the Act" means the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 2000 (Act No. 32 of 2000).

Implementation and enforcement of policies

2. (1) The Municipality must, subject to section 3 and any national or provincial legislation regulating local government finance, give effect to –

(a) its tariff policy; and

(b) its credit control and debt collection policy,

drafted and adopted in accordance with sections 74 and 97 of the Act, respectively, by implementing and enforcing such policies.

(2) Any person who lays claim to a rebate or concession under a policy referred to in subsection (1), must provide the information required and meet the obligations imposed by such policy.

Publication of policies

3. A policy referred to in section 2 and any amendment thereto must be published in the *Provincial Gazette*.

Short title

4. This By-law shall be called the Tariffs, Credit Control and Debt Collection By-law, 2010.
