The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and / or re-advertise or to reject any formal tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest formal or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points. Potential bidders should note that all projects in terms of this tender may not materialize.


Formal tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of 80/20 Preference Point System prescribed by the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2011) and the Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy.

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Following conditions will apply to the tender

- The Tenderer must be registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD).
- An original Tax Clearance Certificate must be submitted
- An original or certified Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (BBBEE) Certificate must be submitted to obtain point for BBBEE Status Level.
- Completed MBD 4, 6.1 and 9 must be submitted.
- Price quoted must be valid for at least 90 days
- Price quoted must be firm and inclusive of VAT
- Proof of no monies being owed to municipality. Paid-up municipal accounts for the company and the directors of the company. If company is leasing for a third party, the valid lease agreement and the paid-up municipal account must be provided.

No tender will be considered to persons in the service of the state.
